International Day for Disaster Risk Reduction and COP26 for Climate Change

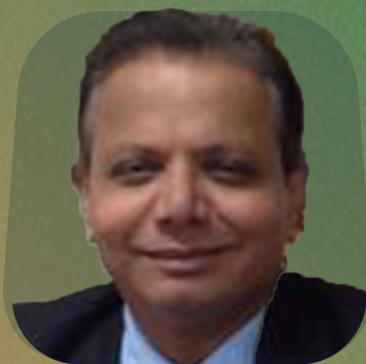

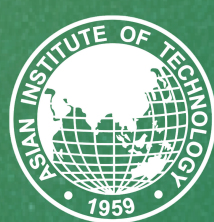
